

## Household Questionnaire Review Notes

### General points

Aim of new questionnaire: to gain feedback from residents to enable a 5 year plan to be created to guide the Parish Council's future agenda.

Questionnaire should be clear and concise. Free format fields should be avoided where possible. There should be a comments section at the end of the questionnaire to enable people to mention things that they may not have had an opportunity to raise.

### Review process

The last household questionnaire from Winter 1999 was used as a starting point as it received a positive response from the village. Each question was taken in turn to decide whether it be included/amended/removed (I/A/R) from the new questionnaire. New questions (N) were suggested as we went through this process.
